





Primary Years Program Term 3

PYP Exhibition

Students in Year 6 have begun work on their PYP Exhibition.

The Exhibition is the culmination of learning from students' entire time in the program and is showcase their designed to knowledge, understanding, skills and attitudes, along with their ability to take action on issues. The Exhibition will be based around the theme of Sharing the planet, with a focus this year on looking toward the year 2040. This focus is based on the book and movie, 2040 by Damon Gameau, which students spent some time looking at this week. They began with some discussion and brainstorming around global issues which will potentially impact what the world will look like in 2040, and they have also started work on art pieces based around their initial thinking about these issues.

The PYP Exhibition will be different this year to previous years' exhibitions, due to the challenges we face as a result of COVID-19. We will keep parents and members of the community updated about plans for Exhibition and just what format will be involved.

What's cooking this week in SAKG?

In this weeks SAKG lesson, the Year 5 students were introduced to knife skills.

Listed are some basic rules:

- Only use a knife if you have been asked to or if you have asked permission.
- Always hold a knife by the handle, never by the blade.
- Never point a knife towards a person, including yourself.
- Always use a chopping board.
- Grip the knife handle firmly with your hand.
- Form your other hand into a bear's claw. Keep your fingernails out of view; don't
- forget to tuck in your thumb!Use your knuckles as a guide.
- NEVER put a knife into a sink of water.
- Always carry a knife with your arm by your side and the knife's blade pointing towards the floor.

- Peaceful Kids is an <u>8 week</u> program for
