At Worship and Praise Andrew told the story of "Bob the Bird". It is a story about leaving your worries to God. God cares for the birds so surely he will care for us.


Andrew personally signed a book to those students who ordered one.

FOUNDATION EXCURSION to THE ROAD AND CYCLE SAFETY CENTRE RIDGEHAVEN

Last Thursday the 3 Foundation classes headed to Ridgehaven for some fun leaning at the Road and Cycle Safety Centre. The enclosed open space has a mini-road network which gives children a real-life experience as they learn how to ride a bike in a safe and controlled environment.

Students were taught some basic road safety skills including how to:

- Read traffic signals
- Walk across railway and school crossings
- Negotiate roundabouts and gutters
- Recognise traffic signs and line marking
- Cycle on roads or footpaths

"I got to ride the little owl hooty bike" said Abigail P

"I learnt some bike safety rules and learnt how to ride a balance bike" said Lucy McC

"We were told not to wear a hat with a peak under the helmet - it is too dangerous!" said Jack L "I liked learning about all the signs. Stop is a Red sign, Turn Left anytime with Care sign, Roundabouts" said Sienna N



















Primary Years Program Term 3

Curriculum

Year 3 Unit of inquiry

Our Year 3 classes have been working on a unit of inquiry looking at time.

Central Idea:

Our lives are shaped by our understanding of time

Lines of Inquiry:

- How the movement of the earth affects time
- Different perspectives on understanding and measuring time
- Time and human activity

This week we looked at how seasons work, how we measure years and why our years take as long as they do. We looked at the relationship of years to the orbit of the earth around the sun.

We went to the oval and modelled our solar system so we could compare how long it takes the earth to travel around the sun to the amount of time it takes other planets in our solar system.

We broke into groups for each planet and each group modelled travelling around the sun with their planet.

Our simulation showed we would have a lot more birthdays on Mercury than on Neptune.

Meliah turned 55 on Mercury before our group on Neptune had turned one!

















Primary Years Program Term 3

Foundation Unit of inquiry

Our Foundation classes have been learning all year in their unit of inquiry lessons about keeping healthy and safe.

Central Idea:

In a positive community we care for ourselves and others **Lines of Inquiry:**

- Getting to know ourselves
- Building relationships with others
- Ways we can keep safe
- Healthy living

Last week they had an opportunity to visit the road and cycle safety centre at Ridgehaven to learn about how to keep safe on the roads. Students could look at how our road rules work and how to keep safe on the road while riding their bikes. They had a great time.






Foundation Physical Education
