But during that minutes silence this week my mind drifted back to this time last year when we spent a week visiting the war fields in northern France.

Fromelles, the Somme, Bullecourt, Messines, Passchendaele, Villers-Bretonneux, Hamel, Amiens, Poziers and Mont St Quentin. We spent time at all of them and came away with more questions than answers. How could this happen? 46,000 Australians died in France in WW1 alone. 1,400,000 people killed altogether at a rate of 900 per day. Their graves marked by little cemetery plots of white crosses, criss crossing the country side every where you go.



This Remembrance Day, as Hippo so beautifully played the Rouse, it was a poignant reminder that in Jesus every day is a new day. And that the sun will rise tomorrow because the Son rose a few yesterdays ago.

# **PYP Evaluation**



In Week 4 we were visited by a team from the IB for our PYP Evaluation. Every five years IB schools go through a rigorous evaluation process, with the aim of identifying areas of strength, areas for development and future goals to assist the process of continuous improvement.

The evaluation visit was a virtual visit this year and our evaluation team looked at classrooms and teaching, looked at the school's documentation and talked to teachers, parents, students, school council and leadership. The process was a very positive one, with some valuable insights provided by the team about effective delivery of our education program.

The evaluation team spoke very positively of their meetings with members of our school community and were particularly impressed by the work our teachers are doing at the school and by the students they met. The evaluation report will be forwarded to the school within the next ten weeks.

# Year 5 Unit of inquiry

Our Year 5 students have been working all year on a unit of inquiry, looking at the Arts and how we express our ideas:

#### Central Idea:

We use our imagination to express ideas creatively

#### Lines of Inquiry:

- What motivates creativity
- Different ways of expressing ideas
- Critiquing and reflecting on artistic expression



During this unit students have learned about and experimented with a range of different artistic styles and forms. Over several weeks students have been fortunate enough to work with a visiting artist, one of our school parents, Kyle Armstrong. They have been working on a mural on sustainability, a key focus in our school. A big thank you to Kyle for giving up his time to come in and help our students out with this.

# Year 6 Exhibition

Our Year 6 students have been working hard over the last term to take part in inquiries and put together presentations for the 2020 Exhibition. Due to COVID-19 restrictions, our Exhibition has had to be presented online this year. Students did visit classes to run electives sessions with the other year levels in the school and we have seen some very impressive investigations into a range of issues.

# Year 4 Unit of inquiry

As part of their unit, they visited Parridla Taikondi in Gawler on Wednesday to look at a place which is significant to local Kaurna people, and to find out more about why it is significant.

# Year 2 Unit of inquiry

The Year 2 students have been inquiring into how plants grow and change and our responsibility to take care of the world.



Ecosystems consist of interdependent organisms

# Lines of Inquiry:

- How plants grow and change

They explored the school garden and the variety of plants within it. In groups they took photos of the plants they were interested in and investigated their features and functions.





# Year 3 Unit of inquiry

Our new unit of inquiry 'How the World Works' the focus is on Heat.

For the tuning in activity, students were asked to melt three chocolates in different ways around the school.

A discussion was had about the observations, what they noticed and why.

"Food art" was also a link in with the unit of inquiry on heat. Discussions were around the impact that heat has on spaghetti including the change in shape and consistency.

Cooked spaghetti was then used o create our own piece of Art.
