Our Year 3 students are working on a unit of inquiry looking at heat.


#### Central Idea:

Understanding the properties of heat allows people to use it in different ways

## Lines of Inquiry:

- Ways heat is produced
- Changes caused by heat
- Challenges with using, storing and transferring heat

To demonstrate their understanding of the unit, students designed and built ovens to cook/melt some chocolate and marshmallows. They came up with some great inventions.
