



Year 5/6 Electives

Last week our Year 5 and 6 students were introduced to a new program at Immanuel Gawler – the **Year 5/6 ICT electives.**

We have been fortunate enough to have the tech team from Prosperity IT working with us during last year and so this year they are sharing their expertise to help us run electives with the Year 5 and 6 students which will be focusing specifically on technology. Students have been able to choose from a range of topics to look into more deeply over the next five weeks. Some of the options available include:

- Design
- Visual art
- Coding
- Animation
- Hands-on hardware
- Movie making

This is a great opportunity for these students and it will be an exciting five weeks as students develop their own ICT projects.



We have been seeing (and hearing) some wonderful creative work from students in Years 2-4 as they have explored rhythm and beats using the djembe drums. Students have looked at how musical notation is used to show rhythm in written form and they have used this musical notation to write and play their own beats. It's been noisy, but a lot of fun.

Peaceful Kids program


'Peaceful Kids' is a Mindfulness and Positive Psychology based program to lessen anxiety and stress and increase resilience in children. The program gives children the skills, practice and support to utilize coping strategies that lessen the symptoms of anxiety and stress. The program also involves parental involvement and commitment to supporting the strategies at home

Outcomes of the Peaceful Kids program:

- Lessen symptoms of anxiety and stress in children
- Teaches children to self-calm
- Empowers children to manage their own anxiety
- Develops emotional intelligence skills
- Teaches children life-long skills to manage stress and prevent stress build up
- Supports children so they know that they are not alone with suffering from anxiety

Program structure:

- Peaceful Kids is a 8 week program for children
- Sessions are for approximately 1 hour each week. (40-50 minutes for Rec and Year 1's)
- Sessions include learning a range of mindfulness strategies and meditations and positive psychology exercises.
- Students are guided through meditations daily online via the Peaceful Kids website: peacefulkids.com.au

NORTHERN DISTRICTS CRICKET CLUB TALENT IDENTIFICATION SESSIONS

The Northern Districts Cricket Club will be conducting Talent Identification Sessions for the Under 14 & 16 Teams and the U12 Development Team on Monday March 15th and 22nd .



All players for these competitions need to be aged under 14, or 16, as of the 1st of September 2021.

The Under 12 <u>Development Squad</u> will train once per week at the club with various high performance coaching staff and play a series of trial matches against other grade clubs.

All players for this squad need to be aged under 12 as of the 1st of September 2021.

From the eligible players that are successful in the Under 12 and Under 14 squads, a Ray Sutton Shield Competition Team will also be selected. The Ray Sutton Shield is a five-week competition for primary school aged cricketers (Years 5, 6 and 7) and is played on 1st Grade ovals on Sunday afternoons in October and November. The Ray Sutton Shield forms a key part of South Australia's cricket pathway.
