



Students and Personal Mobile Devices while On-Site

1. Any student who brings a personal mobile device to school must have a completed form (below) signed by a parent/caregiver stating the reason why the device needs to come to school. (A mobile device includes smart watches or any other device that can send and receive phones calls, messages or data.)
2. Students who have a form indicating parental/caregiver permission and bring a mobile personal device to school must
 - a. as a matter of priority when entering the school grounds place the device in the appropriate container in the front office. (For students in iGOSH arriving before the office opens this will be managed by iGOSH staff.)
 - b. collect the device from the front office when leaving the school site at the end of the day.
3. Any student who has a personal mobile device while on school grounds without putting the device in the appropriate tray in the front office, will have the device confiscated.
 - a. If confiscated, a staff member will contact the student's parent/caregiver as soon as possible following this to determine appropriate actions/consequences to follow.
4. Any student who uses their device while on school grounds (without the express permission of a staff member) will have the device confiscated.
 - a. If confiscated, a staff member will contact the student's parent/caregiver as soon as possible following this to determine appropriate actions/consequences to follow.
