Christ the King of Kings



SPOTLIGHT ON Stephanie Alexander Kitchen Garden Program (SAKGP) with Mr Tiller

Our Kitchen and Garden program has expanded a little bit this year, to include sessions for Year 2, 4 and 6 this semester. Our Year 2s have had an introduction to the Kitchen and prepared some delicious food like Tzatziki using cucumbers from our garden and making Sandwich Sushi!

Years 4s have been having Garden sessions as well as their Kitchen lessons this term. We've looked at the different tools we use in the garden and also planted some seeds in a couple of sustainable pots, using egg cartons and newspaper. We've used lots of our garden produce in our cooking too, making things like fritters, vegetable pancakes, fruit and savoury muffins, along with both tzatziki and eggplant dips.

Year 6s have been looking at the concept of square metre gardening in preparation for the Street Eats Night next term. We've also used plenty of produce from the garden to practice our cooking skills and start to look at cuisines connected to the cultures that the students are inquiring into in their LOTE lessons. We also learn about preserving foods for use later in the year and have dried some of or tomatoes and figs.

Particularly for our Kitchen sessions, we rely on and benefit from having adult volunteers come and assist the students as they prepare and cook different foods. CURRICULUM UPDATE

We have continued this week with our focus on building positive classroom cultures across the school and exploring our school's core values: Love, Grace, Quality and Teamwork.

In the early years at Immanuel, students have been inquiring into social emotional learning as they navigate the new school year.

In Foundation as well as growing in their understanding of how school works, students have investigated 'the Immanuel way', developing their understanding of the school values of love, teamwork, quality and grace.

In year 1 students are building on their prior knowledge of school by investigating ways of becoming independent in recognizing their emotions and the emotions of others. The learning of the Year 1 students will then be shared with the Foundation students to help them further their investigations into the Immanuel way.

Similarly, in Year Two, students have used their observation skills to work out unique strategies that enable them to become more personally responsible for the part that they play in contributing to a positive learning community.

We look forward to the Year 2 students leading Assembly on Monday 18/3 @ 2:30pm, sharing their discoveries with the community.

It is wonderful to see the progression of learning from self to community over the early years through these units. As the year progresses, students will revisit these

concepts often and the learning in these units will have an ongoing impact during the rest of the year.

It has been such a privilege to work with and get to the students and teachers in the Early Years and I'm very much looking forward to our further inquiries this year.

<u>PEACEFUL KIDS PROGRAM AT IMMANUEL</u> - Peaceful kids is a mindfulness and positive psychology based program. Andrea White has facilitated this program for many Immanuel Students over the last 5 years.

Outcome: Teach children to self calm, Manage their anxiety /stress. Sessions include learning a range of strategies, mediations, positive exercises and skills.

Duration: Program is held at school - 8 weeks 1 hour session / 5 weeks 5,6 & 7 year olds 45 minute sessions.
