All bookings to be made through the Spike Booking App Bookings open Friday 15<sup>th</sup> March at 6pm Bookings close Friday 5<sup>th</sup> April Some days are capped so get in quick....

Once bookings are confirmed, consent forms will be available on Operoo. If you make bookings and don't receive a confirmation and consent form via Operoo please contact Katrina (iGOSH Director)

The Consent forms are to be completed before Wednesday 10th April

iGOSH accounts need to be up to date with only 1 week of fees outstanding to use the service for these holidays. If accounts have outstanding amounts of more than the previous weeks fees, bookings will not be confirmed.

# Fee Increase

Late Cancellation Fee: \$15 per child per day

Cancelling bookings after the cut off date (Friday 5<sup>th</sup> April) and with more than 24 hours notice of the day booked will incur a \$15 fee, per child per day. This fee is required to offset the cost incurred by "No Shows" – since staffing and activities are organised and costed to meet the expected number of children. However, if you give less than 24 hours notice or simply not attend then you will be charged the full rate for the day.

If you wish to cancel a booking 24 hours notice must be given Full fee will apply if cancellation is after this time frame

#### Vac Care Fees

Permanent Booking - a permanent booking is considered as any booking made online prior to Vac Care bookings closing. (5/4)

Home Day \$60 Incursion \$65 Excursion \$70

Casual Booking - a casual booking is considered as any booking made during the vacation care period, after bookings have closed online. These are "last minute" bookings and will be charged accordingly.

Home Day \$70 Incursion \$75 Excursions \$80

#### SunSmart

- Our sun smart policy is based on the UV levels
- Each day the UV rating is checked and the sun protection times added to our sun smart poster.
- Children will need to wear sun protection when the UV is 3 or greater. (In line with the Sun Smart recommendations)
- At this time of the year the UV is still within the sun smart range for sun protection.
- Hats <u>are compulsory</u> this Vac care. We will not supply spare hats.
- We have Hat Tubs at iGOSH that are stocked with hats. Your child may have a hat here, so please check this over the next week before the vacation care starts. If children do not have a hat on the day, families will be charged \$13 for a new school hat. This hat will be named and left at the service for your child to use.
- Please apply the first coat of sunscreen at home or use our iGOSH sunscreen station (mirror / wipes / sunscreen)
- We will re-apply sunscreen each day at recess, lunch and afternoon breaks.
- If your child has an allergy or preferred sunscreen please make sure that it is left at OSHC with educators with your child's name on it.
- Your help with this each day your child attends iGOSH during the holidays is appreciated.

# **General** Bits

- Children must be signed in and out every day by an adult.
- Any extra medication requirements need to be given to Senior Educators on the day.
- We collect all the medications from the school front office for the holiday period.
- Please arrive 15 mins before scheduled departure times on excursion days.
- We supply a fruit break and light snack each afternoon, around 3.30pm.
- Activities start around 9:00am and finish around 3.00pm unless specified in the program.

#### What Children need to bring each day

- Recess and Lunch/Snacks (unless stated otherwise) and a drink bottle.
- Children need to wear appropriate clothing for the days and activities planned.
- Please refer to the day plans for what the children need to bring.
- Children need to have their shoulders covered when outdoors. So thin strapped shirts, tank tops and dresses will need to have a t shirt underneath.
- Children are not to wear thongs unless it is a planned water day.
- All children need to wear rashies for water fun / swimming days.

#### **Excursions**

All Excursions will depart on time, which is around 9am. If your child(ren) are not on time the bus will leave and no phone call will be made by iGOSH educators. For any enquiries/problems you may contact the iGOSH mobile 0447 661 555

#### Accounts

iGOSH invoices are required to be paid weekly. Accounts are strictly 7 days

If you choose not to use direct debit or haven't returned the form, then it is important that you are aware of the following:

- Weekly invoices are emailed each Tuesday morning.
- Families have until Friday 1pm to pay the weeks fees.
- If accounts are still outstanding at 1pm Friday then the booking app / future bookings will be blocked.
- This will mean that bookings for the week ahead will be cancelled until the payment is received.
- Once payment is received, bookings will then be permitted through the App.
- If this occurs on more than 2 occasions, accounts will be blocked and direct debit forms will need to be submitted to be able to use the service.
- Your account needs to be in credit or \$0 by 1pm Friday for you to access the booking App and your bookings stay secure for the next week.
- Payment can ONLY be paid by bank transfer over the holidays as the school office is closed.
- Direct Debit payments will be debited from your account between 1-4pm each Friday.
