When: Fridays from 2.10 to 3.10pm

Who: Students from Yr 1-7 (Foundations will do play investigations during this time.) Students grouped in Yr 1-3 and 4-7.

Who leads: All staff (teachers and curric LSOs) and parent volunteers. (Volunteers must have fulfilled volunteer requirements.) Leaders pass on their 'topic', location and maximum numbers. Some topics may run for longer than two weeks.

Resourcing: Resourcing is available for those wishing to offer something that needs it.

How: students make a choice for two weeks – weeks 2/3, 4/5, 6/7, 8/9 – electives are announced to students on a Wednesday (of the even weeks) and they choose their elective. Groupings are posted on a Thursday leaving enough time for preparation for the Friday.

Essential requirements: Students will not be allowed to participate in Friday Electives if their behaviour or attitude doesn't warrant it - red cards, substantial incompleteness of work etc.
