

FIRST AID INFORMATION

If your child is injured at school they are sent to the Health Centre in the office for some first aid. Most first aid performed is recorded into our computer system. Parents are advised of their child's injuries and first aid administered via an email if necessary. If it is a serious injury or sickness we will telephone parents straight away.


