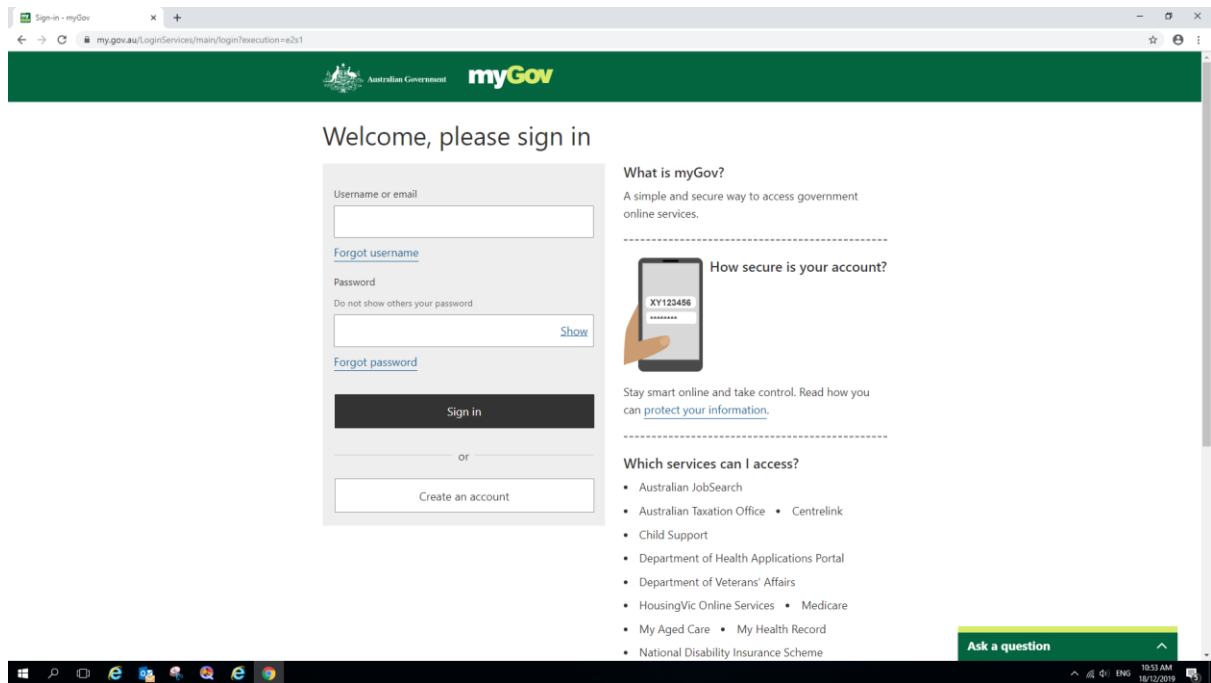
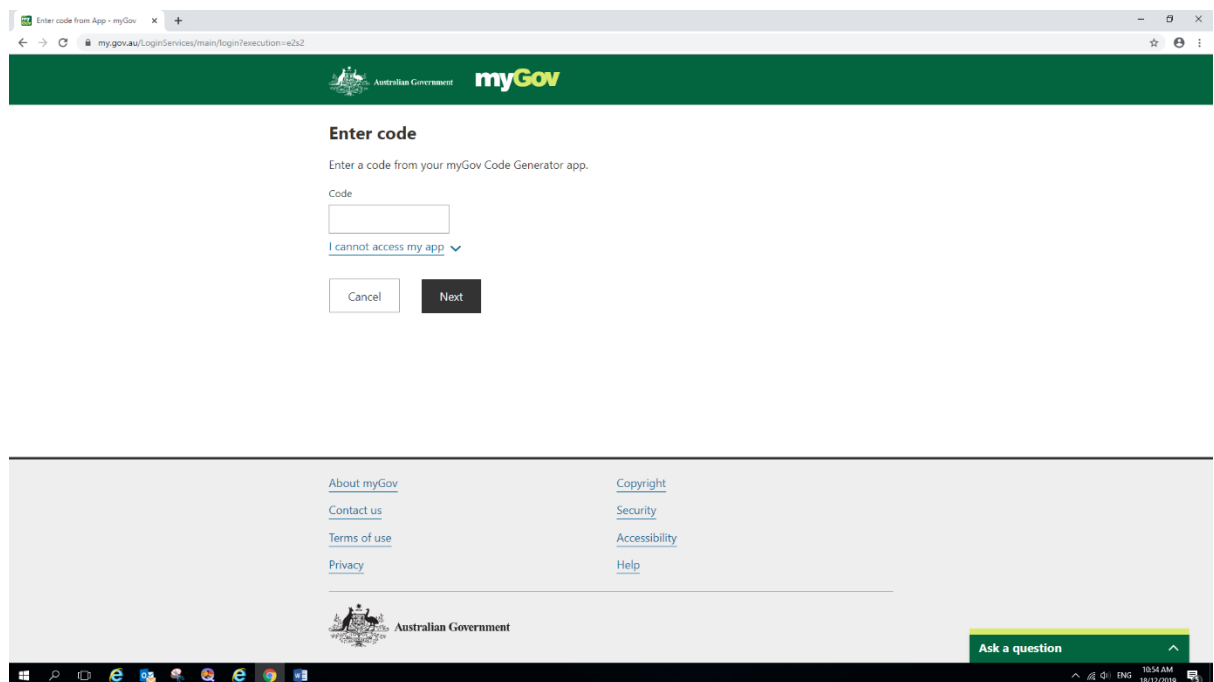


How to Locate your IMMUNISATION HISTORY STATEMENT

1. Go to my.gov.au and sign in with your details:



2. Enter code from the myGov Code Generator app:



3. Select the Medicare logo. If you haven't got this, link Medicare to your myGov online service.
